

SOUND DESIGNER: DYNAMIC FLIGHTS

MAYA PRODUCTIONS

Maya Productions makes diverse theatre that creates change, bringing together organisations and individuals who passionately want their work to enable social change and racial justice. We create opportunities for people of all ages, abilities, culture and classes to experience theatre.

We make work led by Global Majority artists, involve underrepresented communities in creative activities and promote workforce diversity across the arts.

Applications are encouraged from the Global Majority who are currently under-represented in the arts sector.

THE PROJECT

We are recruiting a Sound Designer for production of a new piece of theatre, Dynamic Flights. This play has been developed over 2023 and 2024 through two phases of participatory creative sessions with residents in two Sheffield housing schemes for people living with long term Mental III Health. The show will tour in South Yorkshire with a professional cast and creative team, and participants will be part of the rehearsal process.

The first phases of the project were funded by the Baring Foundation. Their research **Creatively Minded** highlighted "few diverse-led, organisations were specifically devoted to arts and health work and that ethnically diverse people were not well represented, either as service users or within the workforce of the arts and health organisations" (2020)

A key aspect of this project is to develop the skills and career progression of Black, South Asian, East Asian and global majority arts practitioners, to work in the arts and mental health sector.

THE ROLE

We are seeking a Sound designer who will bring together the sound and music elements to realise the full potential sound world of Dynamic Flights. The play also has original compositions/songs, composed by Dan Loops.

Key duties will include:

- Create a sound design suitable to realise the full potential of the music and sound of the show.
- Create a soundtrack/soundscapes and other sound material that fits with the vision of the production.
- Work with the composer to ensure that the musical elements work to their vision.
- Design a sound system to give the audience the best experience of the show in a range of community venues.
- Deliver the sound design and system in a format suitable for touring the show.
- Trouble-shoot any sound production or technical issues that arise.
- Work with the Production Manager to obtain quotes for any equipment needed and ensure that the sound budget is adhered to.Generally support the company to realise the performance to the highest standards.
- You will be required to attend a number of agreed design meetings, production meetings, rehearsals and be in attendance during production week up to and including performance 3.

Person Specification:

Below is a list of the experience, skills and attributes that we're looking for but we know that not everyone can meet all of them. If you don't think you have everything on the list but know that you could make a real difference to Maya then we encourage you to make an application.

- Demonstrable experience of sound design for theatre.
- Experience of working with singers, and on musicals.
- Sound editing skills including such as Avid media Composer
- An understanding of how sound works alongside other elements, including set, lighting, moving image, or an interactive virtual world
- The ability to record in a studio and on location
- Good communication and interpersonal skills with the ability to work effectively with performers and creative teams.
- Attention to detail
- Excellent time management.
- Ability to prioritise workload effectively
- Ability to work independently and to deadlines.
- Musicality, including an understanding of musical genres, timbre, rhythm, and melody
- Experience with sound systems and computer software such as QLab
- Sheffield/South Yorkshire based.

Recent Achievements:

Over the past 2 years, Maya Productions has reached over 7,000 audiences and visitors, employed 150 Global Majority artists and practitioners, and involved hundreds of participants from underrepresented communities in creative activities. We toured our Offie nominated, bi-lingual and interactive Latin American musical - <u>Súper Chefs</u> by Betsy Picart with music by Ariel Cubría from October 2024.

Other activities include *Routes to Routes - A South Asian Heritage Project*. Working creatively with communities in Bradford, Croydon and Sheffield to explore themes around migration this participation project is inspired by Maya's new musical in development *Benny and the Greycats*.
